Dear Potential Black/BIPOC Community Partner:

BLACKS will have 25 students each year entering our program. As part of the program,

BLACKS will partner with Black/BIPOC Community Partners that will offer students community service opportunities. Community service opportunities can be during an event, after school, or during the summer months. If community service opportunities are during the school year, the hours are limited to Monday-Friday for 2-10 hours a week during the school year. This opportunity will give students the chance to give back. Additionally, it is important for Black/BIPOC students to see people who look like them in leadership roles. This will help to instill confidence in terms of possibilities for their own success in life. We only ask that students in BLACKS be given letters of recommendations for their service to your organization.
